## **Resource Pack**

## Number and access

- Total number: 1
- Access: this is not a walk-in facility. Access will be following recommendation by a healthcare professional e.g. 999 or transfer from Urgent Care Centre

## Services

- Assessment & up to 24hr care units
- Trauma unit (as part of trauma network)
- Required clinical adjacencies:
  - Radiology & Pathology
  - Blood bank
  - Pharmacy
  - Critical Care Unit
  - Emergency surgery – trauma and general
  - Short Stay Beds – at least for <3 day LOS
  - Paediatric unit (or emergency paediatric care)
  - Urgent Care Centre (UCC)

## Co-location options

- Diagnostic and Treatment Centre (DTC)

## Number and access

- Total number: not yet decided
- Access: this is a walk-in facility or telephone triage (e.g. NHS 111), 'planned' urgent care, ambulance

## Services

- Providing paediatric, adult, frailty and mental health urgent care
- Ultrasound & Plain Xray
- Simple blood tests
- Observation units – paediatric (6hrs) and adult (12hrs)
- Pharmacy
- Potential for integrated social and mental health services
- Required clinical adjacencies:
  - Ambulatory rehabilitation services

## Co-location options

- Community Unit (CU)
- Health Hub (HH)
- Local Planned Care (LPC)
- GP emergency appointments
- Out of Hours (OOH)

### **Number and access**

- Total number: 1
- Access: this is a planned surgery facility so by medical referral

### **Services**

- 80% planned surgery
- Most day case - some beds (e.g. planned orthopaedics)
- Major diagnostics – including Ultra Sound, MRI, CT, Nuclear
- Planned endoscopy
- Pathology

### **Co-location options**

- Emergency Centre (EC)

## **Number and access**

- Total number: n/a – this does not require a separate ‘unit’. This requires consultation rooms within existing buildings with ‘virtual’ capabilities.
- Access: patients will be invited to attend appointments for diagnosis/assessment.

## **Services**

- This will provide 70% of assessment, diagnostics and follow up
- Done by a variety of professionals
- Standardised assessment
- Use UCC diagnostics

## **Co-location options**

- UCC (UCC)
- Community Units (CU) (existing community hospital facilities)
- Health Hubs (HH)
- GP surgeries
- Other community facilities

## **Number and access**

- Medium acuity beds, (higher acuity than currently available in community hospitals or care homes)

## **Services**

- High intensity in patient and ambulatory reablement and rehabilitation

## **Co-location options**

UCC (UCC)

Health Hubs (HH)

Existing community hospital facilities

Existing acute hospital facilities

## **Number and access**

- Patient empowerment through a blend of localised prevention, information, self management, navigation and advocacy services
- Partnership between statutory, voluntary and community services

## **Services**

- 'The place I go to when I have a question or a problem'.
- 'Owned' by local communities
- Localised but consistent services

Community Units (CU) (existing community hospital facilities)

Urgent Care Centres (UCC)

Diagnostic and Treatment Centre (DTC)

Other existing community facilities
